## The Beach at – Coronado Golf Course

On a hot summer day, one of the nicer places to sail to is the beach at the Coronado Golf Course. It is not very big but it is seldom crowded. The access is from San Diego Bay or limited access from the Coronado Golf Course. It is a well protected anchorage with the prevailing winds keeping the boats parallel to the beach. The trip takes you through some of the sites in San Diego harbor and under the Coronado Bridge. The bridge is big enough to block the wind so stay away from the footings when going through when under sail. It takes about 2 hours one way but it is worth the effort. O yes; if someone shouts “**FOUR**” duck!
